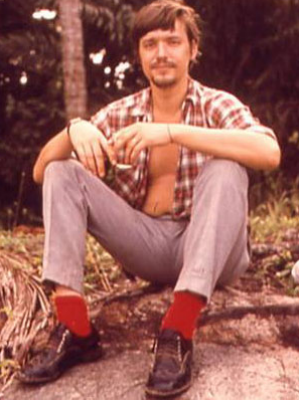
HERPETOLOGIA KOENIGIANA
